

Rules for Columbia Adult Soccer Association Games

Rules for Regular Season Games:

1. **The Administrator of CASA (Bob Winfield)** - has the right to stop or cancel any game for any reason.
2. **All Red Cards** must be called into CASA before 7:00 PM the day of the game. (360) 892-7363.
3. **Yellow Cards** – do not have to be called in, just include them in your game report.
4. **We have a Two Red Card Rule:**
 - a. If **One** team gets two Red Cards in a game, the game will be abandoned at the time of the second red card is issued. The team with two Red Cards loses. If each team has only one Red card each, the game will continue.
5. **All rosters must be checked** – No roster for you, No game shall be played. No players are allowed to be added to a roster for any reason, unless the Administrator/ Registrar personally ok's it. There is a line just below the last player listed as follows: **“CASA REGISTRAR BOB WINFIELD THIS IS THE DOWNLOADABLE ROSTER, NO ADDITIONS ARE ALLOWED BELOW THIS LINE.”** No names shall be allowed to be added after that line.
6. **All Cards must be checked** – If a Players Card or Temporary Card is expired, they are not allowed to play in the game. No Exceptions. This is your way of insuring you have registered players playing in the games.
7. **There is free substitution of players** - on all Dead balls at the Referee's discretion. Our teams are instructed not to send in more than three players at a time.
8. **Overtime** - There is no overtime in Regular Schedule games.
9. **Time** – Each game is a 90 minute game (2 - 45 minute halves) with a 5 minute break between halves.
10. **Uniforms** – Each player should have a 6” inch number on the back, and all the normal FIFA player equipment. Note: should the Home team have to change their jersey's for a color conflict, their second set of shirts are NOT required to have numbers on them.
11. **Game Reports** – All game reports must be signed. All game reports need to be mailed to CASA (see the web site for address or email instructions) within 48 hours of the game ending. Email (per the instructions) are excepted.
12. **Bad weather** – If there is a possible bad weather, please call the CASA recorder to see if the game is that was scheduled is being played (See phone number after bullet #2). The recorder is updated by 10:00 AM each Sunday morning. Also changes of fields will be on the recorder and called into the Referee Assigner.
 - a. If you arrive at the field and weather becomes too bad or unsafe to start or continue to play a game. You have the right to stop a game for bad weather. You must inform both teams.
13. **FIFA** – All other rules not covered above shall be covered by FIFA rules.

Rules for Post Season Playoffs:

1. All the same rules stated above will apply in the Playoffs.
2. Each game in the playoffs must have a **winner**.
 - a. If the game ends in regulation as a tie. There will be a possible two 7 ½ minute overtime periods played. There will be no golden goal. If one team is ahead at the end of the first overtime period the game will end. If still tied, a second overtime will be played.
 - b. If no winner is determined after the second overtime period. Penalty kicks will determine the winner.
